**BERMUDA TO HOST THE BEST OF THE BEST DURING THE
2009 PGA GRAND SLAM OF GOLF**

HAMILTON, BERMUDA, August 27, 2009 – Excitement in Bermuda is booming surrounding the announcement of the four qualifying players for the 27th PGA Grand Slam of Golf. By winning the 91st PGA Championship, Y.E. Yang of South Korea qualified for the final spot in the PGA Grand Slam of Golf at the Port Royal Golf Course October 19th to October 21st, 2009. The Grand Slam is the world’s most difficult tournament to qualify for because invitations are guaranteed only to the winners of the year’s four major championships.

Mr. Yang has garnered an invitation to join British Open Champion Stewart Cink, U.S. Open Champion Lucas Glover and Masters Champion Angel Cabrera in qualifying for golf’s season-ending showcase. Mr. Cabrera won the Bermuda pink jacket in 2007 when the tournament was hosted at the Mid Ocean Club.

This year the tournament moves to the Port Royal Golf Course for the first time – one of Bermuda’s public golf courses. Port Royal was officially re-opened last month after a multimillion dollar reconstruction project.

“Congratulations to the four qualifying players for this year’s PGA Grand Slam of Golf,” said Bermuda’s Premier, Minister of Tourism and Transport, Dr. the Hon. Ewart F. Brown, JP, MP. “Bermuda is ready to host the year’s best golfers to compete for the Grand Slam prize on one of the finest public courses on the planet. With the eyes of the golfing world on Bermuda for two days in October, we trust the new Port Royal will make the same impression on the world it has made on all of us.”
